Product Category: Con-Verse Bluetooth® by Rostra

Condition: When an iPhone™ is paired to the Con-Verse *Bluetooth*® system, the radio is muted for 3-5 seconds when audible notifications such as text message and voicemail alerts are received.

Explanation: While the above condition is the normal operation of both the phone and the Con-Verse system when paired together, muting the sounds from the phone when connected will eliminate the interruption of the audio from the radio during normal driving.

Solution: This condition can be eliminated in one of two ways using the below steps:



Use the mute switch on the side of the phone to turn off all sounds while driving. Your phone will stay paired to your Con-Verse system but will no longer try to stream audible alerts through your vehicle's speakers.

A) Unlock your phone to access the icons on the home screen.



B) Select "**Settings**" from your phone's home screen.



C) Select "**Sounds**" from your phone's Settings menu.



D) Disable the individual sounds for audible alerts.
